Booths are rented on a first come, first served basis. The art market consists of original arts or crafts, please no resellers or mass produced items. Vendors are responsible for any tables, chairs, etc needed for set up. A limited number of canopies are available to rent.

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## **Important Event Information**

Vendors may apply for the June 27th and/or the September 12th dates.

The events will be held 1 pm to 7 pm, rain or shine. The vendor must be present during those times.

Booth setup begins at 11 am on the day of the event. Booth tear down must be completed by 9 pm the day of the event. Vendors are responsible for setup and tear down of booths. Event will be held rain or shine.

Running water and power are not available.

Art work exhibited during the festival must consistent with images and descriptions provided in the application. Applications without images will not be considered.

All applications are subject to approval, if not approved, all fees will be fully refunded.

Any vendors who have not completed the application and paid in full by 5/20/15, may not be considered.

Refund/cancellation policy: Refunds of 50% if you have notified us by 6/12/15.

Food vendors must provide all food and heating equipment, but will be given electrical access. All food trucks will be subject to inspection by the local health department the day prior to the event, and must provide permit for approval.

Artists are responsible for insuring their property while participating in the Beacon Art Walkabout.

All vendors must comply with the laws of Washington State, King County, and the City of Seattle, and to obtain any and all permits and sales tax necessary from the state, county and city.
